### PLACEMENT INFORMATION

**Job Description:**

*Detailed cleaning of guest rooms, public spaces, bathrooms, pool area and hallways. Cleaning of parking lots and entrances. Removing linens and trash from guest rooms. Folding laundry, empty and load washers and dryers, stocking linens.*

*Housekeepers perform a combination of cleaning duties to maintain guest rooms and/or public hallway areas in a clean and orderly manner. Guest rooms may include: bedrooms, toilet/shower area, Job duties may include:*

- Removing and collecting linens for laundering and transporting them to designated areas.*
- Cleaning rugs, carpets, and upholstered furniture using vacuum cleaner.*
- Dusting furniture and equipment.*
- Emptying wastebaskets and cleaning them inside and out.*
- Cleaning tiled floors with the use of brooms and mops.*
- Using chemical-based products to clean tubs, sinks, counter tops, mirrors, toilets, door panels and shower curtains.*
- Replenishing trash bags, soaps, bathroom items, and other supplies.*
- Transporting all trash and waste to disposal areas, as instructed.*
- Removing items from refrigerator, stove, and microwave.*
- Cleaning refrigerator inside and out.*
- Demonstrate a high level of customer service. Respond to and take appropriate action to resolve concerns and complaints of guests.*
- Keep supervisor/manager informed of situations relating to facility operation, patron complaints or concerns, accidents, emergency*

situations, damages, and potential safety hazards.

•Attend departmental and team meetings as well as participate in all additional training courses.

•Perform all duties in a safe manner.

•Employees may be asked to move to different locations or job assignments within the property, as needed. Other duties may be assigned. There are 2 possible shifts that students would work day shift (8:30am to 4pm) or night (4pm–10pm). The "Night" Shift would consist of mostly cleaning public spaces and laundry. The "Day" Shift would be more cleaning individual rooms.

You can email your manager, Wendy Anderlot at [wendy.anderlot@marriott.com](mailto:wendy.anderlot@marriott.com) - she will be able to provide a list of housing resources, such as names of people who rent houses/rooms to students. It will be YOUR responsibility to secure housing before you arrive into the country. Students should expect to pay around \$150 per week. It might not have a lot of amenities. Many accommodations do not come with a washer or dryer. There might not have access to a kitchen and if you do it might not be a full kitchen or it could be shared. The accommodations could be small and not have a closet or not have a lot of closet space. Often times students will bike to work – depending on the distance and your speed commutes can take around 45 minutes. Students should be prepared that accommodations could be aware from 1 to 5 miles from employer. Students are **STRONGLY** encouraged to research housing options online and secure housing prior to arrival.

Cape Cod has very LIMITED public transportation. There is a regional bus with limited hours so most student bike or walk everywhere. Often time housing is rather far from “downtown” areas. Students often purchase a bike, helmet, lock and lights.

## ARRIVAL INFORMATION

**Arrival Instructions:**

It will be YOUR responsibility to get from the airport to your housing.

Your work agreement has a start date and an end date. You are expected to work until the last day of your work agreement, the end date. Please plan your travel period and return to university accordingly.

You should plan to arrive into Boston Logan Airport (BOS), and catch a bus to Hyannis. From the bus stop, the hotel is a mile from the bus station, but you should be prepared to take a taxi, Lyft or Uber to your pre-arranged housing. Make sure you have a plan of how to get from the bus station to your housing BEFORE you arrive into America - we want to make sure you have a safe arrival.

Students should plan to arrive to the USA a couple days prior to start of work so they can register in SEVIS and apply for their Social Security Number.
