Arrival and Transportation Information – Ocean City, Maryland

Participants arriving from abroad to work in Ocean City, Maryland should plan their travel carefully to ensure a smooth arrival. The closest major airport is **Baltimore/Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport**, located approximately 140 miles (225 km) from Ocean City. Travel time from the airport to Ocean City is typically **3 to 3.5 hours** depending on traffic.

Participants should plan to arrive **between Monday and Thursday** whenever possible to allow time to settle into housing and prepare for work orientation.

Transportation from the Airport

Participants may use several transportation options:

- **Airport Shuttle Services** – Shuttle services run between the Baltimore airport and Ocean City. Prices typically range from **\$80–\$120 one way**.

- **Bus Service** – Intercity bus services operate between Baltimore and Ocean City.

Typical cost: **\$40–\$70**
- **Rideshare or Taxi** – Services such as Uber and Lyft are available at the airport, but can be expensive for long distances.

Employer Transportation Assistance

If arrival information is received in advance, the employer may help coordinate transportation from a central location in Ocean City to participant housing. Participants must send their **flight details at least 7 days before arrival** so transportation assistance can be arranged if available.

Local Transportation

Ocean City has convenient local transportation:

- **Ocean City Transportation Department Beach Bus** – Runs along Coastal Highway throughout the day and evening.
Cost: about **\$3 per ride or \$4 day pass**

This bus system allows easy travel between housing, work locations, grocery stores, and the beach.
