Participants are in the community and visible to guests including children, therefore should present a clean and professional appearance.

Tattoos are acceptable but should be minimal, not offensive or political in nature. Piercings should be limited to ears, no body piercings. Facial hair is acceptable if kept neatly trimmed and clean. Shirts are provided and participants can wear shorts no shorter than 2" above the knee. At no time should stomachs, buttocks, or cleavage be exposed.
