1). Employees need to appear for work clean and well groomed. We maintain a conservative professional image. Tattoos need be covered. Facial or tongue piercings need to be removed while working. Employees must maintain a professional hair color and style, i.e dying hair bright colors such as pink, blue, green, etc. would not be acceptable.

Applicable Company Policies:

- *To perform this job successfully, you must be able to converse comfortably in English to be able to understand and communicate with customers with the confidence to maintain good eye contact.*
- *A strong candidate for this job is someone with a bright personality, who is a fast learner, who is dedicated to good work, and has a lot of energy!*
- *Employees are required to arrive to work on time.*
- *If calling out sick, we ask that employees let us know as early as possible so we can find a replacement.*
- *Smoking is not permitted inside the property but is permitted in designated smoking areas.*
- *Cell phone use is not permitted during work hours but can be used during break.*
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- *Employer requires students to arrive four days before their start date so that they can give them a tour of the city, where to buy groceries, where to shop, get them settled into their housing, observation period at work getting a tour of the store (which is about an hour per day). This is not paid.*
- *If employee seeks a second job, they can only apply after they have established their position with our company. Employees are permitted to apply for a second job after two consecutive weeks of employment with this company.*
- *Depending on business needs, or if students want to work extra hours, students may be asked to relocate or be reassigned to work at any of the following locations (see below): Students will receive the 32 hours at the store where hired for the season and all stores are within walking/biking distance to the provided housing. Students working on Mackinac Island will be given a ferry transportation pass from the employer.*
