Brief description of housing: The employer arranged housing is a 3 bedroom, 1 bathroom house within walking distance to the worksite.

Housing is shared by 4-6 total participants; 2 per bedroom, each with their own bed. No more than 6 participants per bathroom.

Second Housing Option: 748 Brookline Blvd Apt #1 Pittsburgh, PA 15226 3 bedrooms, 1 bath, living room, kitchen and dining room. 2 students per bedroom, each with own bed.

Both houses are furnished with a full kitchen and all utensils necessary to prepare own meals. Participants need to bring own personal necessities such as clothing and toiletries. Bed linens and towels will be provided.

Port Authority of Allegheny County is the public transit agency for the greater Pittsburgh area, providing bus, light rail, incline and paratransit service to about 230,000 riders daily. Participants whose employment is terminated (involuntary or voluntarily), will have 2 weeks from the time that they end their position to secure permanent housing that complies with Greenheart Exchange's Housing Guidelines and submit a Self-Arranged Job Offer (SAJO) to Greenheart Exchange for consideration. Participant's failure to submit a SAJO within a two-week timeframe will result in shortening the participant's program sponsorship. If Greenheart Exchange rejects SAJO, the participant has 1 business day to resubmit SAJO in accordance with instructions received from Greenheart Exchange.
