Transportation for Community Housing Description:

Most participants walk or bike to work, as housing is usually located 1 to 2 miles from the store. Ocean City is very pedestrian- and bike-friendly, with sidewalks, bike lanes, and flat terrain. Bicycles can be purchased or rented locally from shops like Bike World or Boardwalk Bikes. The town also offers local bus service through Ocean City's Coastal Highway Beach Bus, which runs frequently along the main route with stops every few blocks. A ride-all-day pass costs \$4, and monthly passes are available at discounted rates. The nearest bus stops are typically within a 5-10 minute walk from both housing and the worksite. Transportation is not provided by the employer, but students have plenty of safe and affordable options to commute independently.

We recommend that students fly into Baltimore/Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport (BWI), Washington D.C. airports (DCA/IAD), or New York City (JFK/LGA/EWR). From these major airports, students can reach Ocean City, Maryland, by shuttle, bus, or coordinated group transportation.

Recommended Airports: Baltimore (BWI) – Closest and most convenient (approx. 3.5–4.5 hours to Ocean City). Washington D.C. (DCA or IAD) – About 4–5 hours by bus/shuttle. New York City (JFK, LGA, or Newark) – Longer travel time (approx. 6–8 hours), but often more flight options.

Transportation Options: BayRunner Shuttle (<https://www.bayrunnershuttle.com>) – Direct service from BWI to Ocean City (approx. \$90–\$100). Greyhound Bus (<https://www.greyhound.com>) – Buses from NYC, D.C., or BWI to Salisbury, MD, then local transit or taxi to Ocean City. Shore Transit (<https://www.shoretransit.org>) – Local bus service from Salisbury to Ocean City.

E-Point (<https://ocstudentcenter.com/pick-up-from-airport-and-city/>) and Let's Go (<https://letsgooc.net/Airport-Shuttle/Book-Arrival>)- These J1-focused companies organize group transportation from airports like JFK, DCA, and BWI directly to Ocean City. They also help students with Social Security appointments and local orientation.
