Employees are paid bi-weekly. We issue a paper check initially until the students are settled, then encourage them to set up a bank account for direct deposit.

Grooming Requirements:

We work in a food service environment. Students must wear clean uniform shirts, wear clothing in good shape (nothing torn or damaged), and we encourage students to wear a good shoe as they are on their feet during the shift. Males must be clean shaven, all employees must wear head covering as a hat, headband, or hairnet. Hair must be pulled back, and use of jewelry is limited (one solid ring band per hand), ear rings must be studs only, and use of nail polish is prohibited in food service.

Cell phone use is prohibited within guest view, smoking or vaping not allowed, scheduling is usually done a week or two in advance. Workers must show up on time, in uniform, and ready to work at their scheduled shift time.
