Employer-owned or employer-arranged housing description:

Our housing is on the second floor of our building, it is directly above Bogart's Restaurant and requires a flight of stairs. It is dormitory-style housing in which tenants share a bedroom with one other tenant, with eight people accommodated. Housing units have a shared living area, shared kitchen, & two bathrooms. The kitchen has dishes, pans, a refrigerator, a stove, an oven, a microwave, a dishwasher and a washer/dryer. The shared living space does have a tv. Beds are twin size or full with bedding provided. Utilities and internet are included at no charge. If for any reason a student can not get along with others living in the provided housing, we MAY be able to move them only if another location is available, but their rent is subject to being higher at a different location.

Co-ed housing is a possibility and is determined only by the applicants who arrive.

Billings Logan International Airport

Red Lodge is 60 miles from the nearest airport. Red Lodge Hospitality does not have any required travel days.

We require students to fly into **Billings Logan International Airport (BIL)**, whose website is <https://www.flybillings.com>.

Students will travel by taxi 60 miles from Billings to Red Lodge. The cab fare will be at the expense of Bogart's Restaurant, and the Office Manager will make these arrangements for the student.

Participants arriving after 8:00 p.m. will need to stay overnight in Billings. A taxi will pick them up the following day to take them to Red Lodge. *See after-hours accommodations.

If the flight arrives after 8:00 p.m., please see the instructions below. Once participants arrive in Red Lodge, we will help them settle in their new summer home. Grocery, post office, pharmacy, and banks are all within walking distance from all employee housing and workplace locations.

Our grooming requirements are simply that you arrive bathed and in clean clothes that are not in disrepair. You must have closed-toe shoes, preferably non-slip. Hair that is longer than shoulder length must be tied back. Depending upon the position, different attire may be required. Any logo uniforms will be provided by the employer.

We do not allow our staff to use their cell phones while clocked in unless there is express permission from the manager on duty. This would only be allowed for specific reasons, such as family illness.

Scheduling is done through an online application called 7shifts. Schedules are posted 3 weeks in advance, so staff is required to make any requests for time off no less than 21 days in advance.
