Job Description:

Food Service workers set up and clean up kitchen and table areas, sell/or prepare various food items for customers.

Food Service employees are required to perform various food and beverage related tasks including:

- Cooking or preparing food items according to procedures or recipes.*
- Placing food items on serving plates or dishes along with required condiments and utensils to present to customers.*

- Preparing cold drinks, warm drinks and other non-alcoholic beverages.
- All items must be prepared quickly and accurately ensuring no waste and in accordance with production and portion requirements and quality standards while maintaining a safe, sanitary work environment.
- Food Service employees may be responsible for handling sales which will include: taking correct orders, entering sales in a cash register, taking money, counting out correct change (coins/bills), giving change (coins/bills) to customers, and completing credit card transactions.
- All Food Service employees will be responsible for maintaining and cleaning all Food Service areas including preparation tables, equipment, dishes, floors, supply areas, refrigerators, coolers, sales areas, and customer areas (tables, chairs, serving lines, condiment stands, etc)
- Demonstrate a high level of customer service. Respond to and take appropriate action to resolve concerns and complaints of guests.
- Keep supervisor/ manager informed of situations relating to facility operation, patron complaints or concerns, accidents, emergency situations, damages and potential safety hazards.
- Attend departmental and team meetings as well as participate in all training courses.
- Perform all duties in a safe manner.
- Employees may be asked to move to different locations or job assignments within the property, as needed. Other duties may be assigned.

Typical Schedule:

Holidays, weekends and nights shifts are required. There is 7-10 day notice for all requested days off, if multiple people want the same day off it is not always possible.

All work is weekend only until Memorial weekend and after Labor Day, during the season we are open full time and a minimum of 35 hours must be worked. Weekend, night and holiday shifts are required.

Description: Our town roads can accommodate bike riders. Bikes can be rented from local shops in town. Bikes are not allowed on the boardwalk, students must walk their bike on the boardwalk and are responsible for securing them.

Arrival Instructions:

Students are expected to arrange their own travel to Seaside Heights and communicate their arrival time prior to traveling. Housing arrival times are between 10am - 9pm Monday - Friday. Arrivals after 9pm, and arrivals on Saturdays and Sundays will not be accepted.

Airport

It is most convenient for students to fly into Newark Airport (EWR). JFK Airport in New York is further away and you will experience more traffic and a higher cost of transportation to Seaside Heights.

Train or Bus

The NJ Transit bus can also be taken from Newark Penn Station (a short car/bus ride from Newark Airport). The bus is recommended because it will take you directly to the Toms River Bus Station which is only a 10 minute car/bus ride to Seaside Heights.

From Newark Airport there is an air shuttle available that will take travelers through each of the Newark Liberty Airport Terminals to the NJ Transit Train Station. Travelers can purchase a train ticket to "Point Pleasant Beach Station" for an estimated price of \$20.50. Once you arrive in Point Pleasant Beach, an Uber/Lyft car can take you to your assigned housing in Seaside Heights - this is about a 20 minute car drive.

TRAINING AND ONBOARDING

Pre-Arrival Onboarding: Yes

Onboarding Instructions will be sent to Employees beginning early May 2025.

- Employees will onboard with ADP our payroll company
 - First, Employees will be required to register an account with ADP in order to complete their onboarding documents.

Grooming Requirements:

Must have neat and clean appearance at all times. Issued uniform shirts must be wrinkle and stain free and tucked into khaki pants or shorts. Nose and lip piercings must be removed or a clear stud must worn during working shifts. No extreme hair colors. No open-toed shoes or sandals allowed. Managers will go over details with employees.

We are in the business of fun, and want our employees to have fun while working! We will train you to be your best outgoing self while safely creating long-lasting memories not only for yourself, but for our guests too.

Casino Pier enforces a strict no cell phone policy while on duty. All cell phones must be securely stored away before your shift begins.

Shifts are assigned by the scheduling manager and will be posted two weeks in advance for employees to view. It is the employee's responsibility to check their schedule and arrive on time for their shift. Any requests for additional time off must be submitted at least two weeks in advance, and approval is not guaranteed. If management cannot accommodate a last-minute request, employees may be asked to find someone to cover their shift. All employees are required to work at least one night shift, one weekend shift, and all holiday shifts.

Smoking/vaping is not permitted on any of the Casino Pier & Breakwater Beach properties which also include housing. Employees must leave the property in order to smoke/vape.

Seaside Heights has a noise ordinance that is strictly enforced during the summer, no large parties are allowed in housing. If there are any tickets/fines that are given, it is the responsibility of the tenant(s) to pay.
